Thursday, May 13 → Sunday, May 16 2010

of Portages – 10 – 4.666 mts – 2.9 miles

Distance Paddled – 20 kms - 12 miles

Day 1

Thursday, May 13

- Depart from the Village of Lucan by 6 AM – to Access Point #3 Magnetawan Lake
 - 456 km – 5 hours 41 minutes arriving between 12 noon and 1 PM
 - Eating lunch in vehicle to save time
 - Register and unload gear ready for departure by 2 PM
- 2 PM – depart from Dock – Destination Daisy Lake – 4 miles (6.5 km) with 3 Portages = 610 mts
 - Paddle short distance to first portage
 - Portage #1 – 135 mts
 - Paddle ½ mile to South point of Hambone Lake
 - Portage #2 – 5 mts
 - Paddle ½ mile to portage
 - Portage #3 – 420 mts – Enter Daisy Lake – 8 campsites
 - Paddle ½ to 1 mile East on Daisy Lake to find campsites
- 4-5 PM - Campsite #1 on Daisy Lake – 2 on Island if weather is favorable otherwise there are 2 @ the mouth of the Petawawa River.

Day 2

Friday, May 14

- Up at 6:30 AM – breakfast and break camp – on the water by 8:30 – 9 – Destination Queer Lake – 6 miles (9.6 kms) and with 3 Portages = 3,020 mts
 - From Island campsites – paddle ½ mile to Petawawa River, paddle 1 mile to Portage # 4 – 135 mts
 - Paddle ¼ mile to Portage # 5 – 450 mts
 - Paddle 2 mile to Little Misty Lake – Lunch
 - Portage # 6 – 2435 mts To Queer Lake
 - Enter Queer Lake - Length 1 Mile, 15 campsites
- 3-4 PM – Campsite #2 on Queer lake – 2 sites at the top right near Little Trout Creek portage

Day 3

Saturday, May 15

- Up at 6:30 AM – breakfast and break camp – on the water by 8:30 – 9 – Destination Ralph Bice Lake – 4 miles (6.5 kms) with 2 Portages = 620 mts
 - From camp by Trout Cr Portage – paddle ½ mile to Portage #7 – 175 mts
 - Enter Little trout Lake
 - Paddle approx 1 mile to portage # 8 – 435 mts
 - Enter Ralf Bice Lake – Lunch – 20 campsites available
 - Paddle 2 Miles along north shore to Island Campsite
- 2-3 PM – Campsite #2 Island Campsite - Setup camp

Day 4

Sunday, May 16

- Up at 6:30 AM – breakfast and break camp – on the water by 8:30 – 9 – Destination #3 Entry Point\Exit – 2.5 miles (4 kms) with 2 Portages = 430 mts
 - Paddle 2 Miles to Portage #9 – 295 mts
 - Enter Hambone Lake
 - Paddle ½ Mile to Portage #10 – 135 mts
 - Short Paddle to dock
- Exit – 12 Noon – drive home
